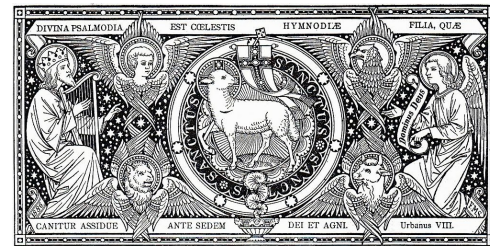

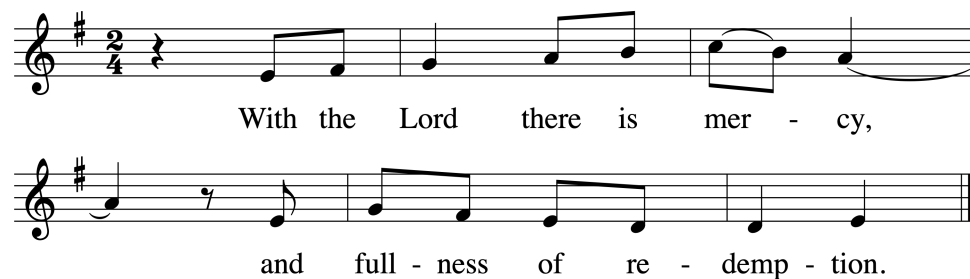

CREED

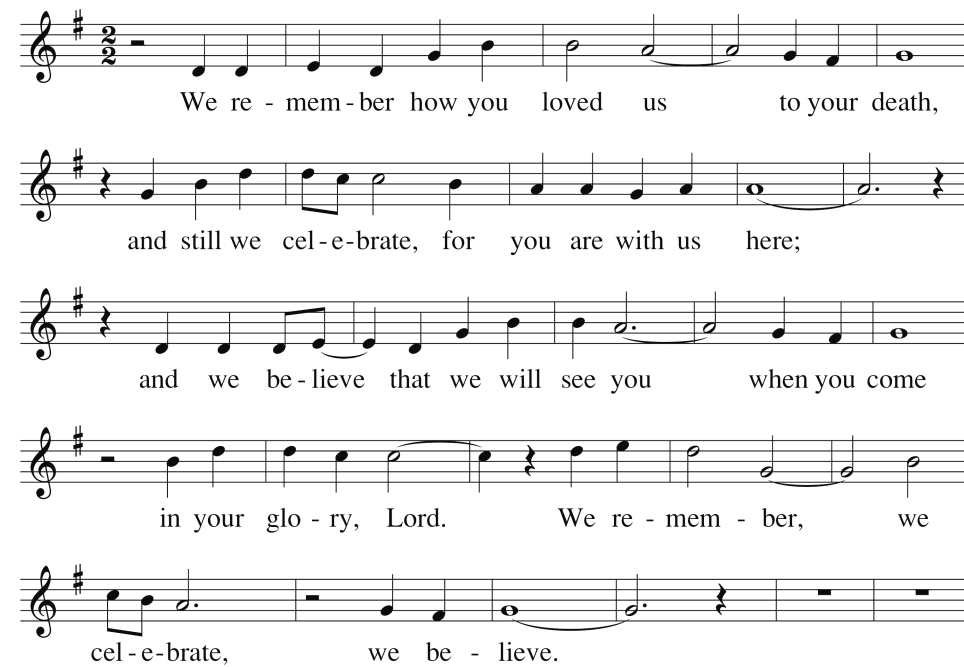

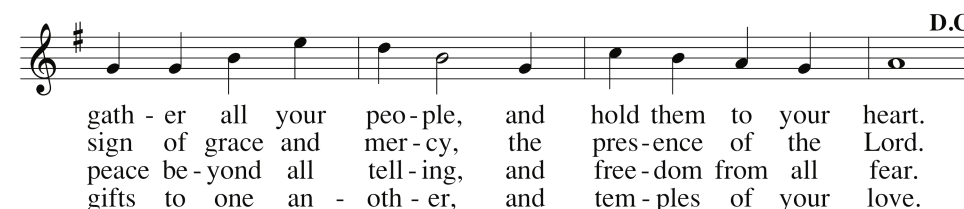
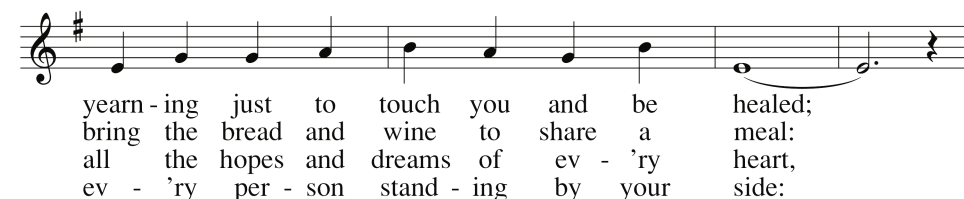
